

Tunnelblick for Mac OS X

A Graphical User Interface for OpenVPN on Mac OS X is a package called *Tunnelblick*. To install this GUI, follow the steps below:

- Download the package from the site <http://www.tunnelblick.net>. It is a Zip compressed file which contains the GUI and the OpenVPN software;
- Double-click on the zip file (we suppose it is located on the Desktop) to extract the only file that contains. The executable file called *Tunnelblick* appears on the Desktop;
- Double-click on the file *Tunnelblick* to start the program. A dialog box appears to alert you that configuration files must be stored in the directory *Library/openvpn/*. Press [Continue] and then close the *openvpn.conf* configuration file. We will not use this example file;
- Tunnelblick is now installed and its icon appears near the clock. At this point, you have to configure OpenVPN to establish the VPN connection with a Anonyproz Servers;
- Download the OpenVPN configuration files for MAC OS X from our [download center](#) and use the Finder to put them in the directory *Library/openvpn* of the user home directory. If you want you can remove the sample file *openvpn.conf* from the folder *Library/openvpn*;
- Close Tunnelblick by clicking the [Quit] item from the menu that appears by clicking on the Tunnelblick's icon. Restart it again by double-clicking on the *Tunnelblick* program. The item [Connect 'Anonyproz Server'] is now available in the Tunnelblick menu. Choose it to start the VPN connection with the Anonyproz OpenVPN Server;
- Select the item [Details...] and then the button [Edit Configuration] in the dialog box which appears. Save the configuration file and exit;
- Start the VPN connection by selecting the item [Connect 'Anonyproz Server']. In the dialog box that appears type the username and password .
